## -----National School Lunch Program-----

### Prices

**Preschool Student Lunch: \$3.00**

**Grades K-8 Student Lunch: Free\***

**Adult Lunch: \$4.95**

**\*Second helpings are not free of charge. Permission is required to receive seconds at a cost to the family's lunch account. See below.**

A complete lunch is at least three different food items. One of these items must be a fruit or vegetable. If children are still hungry they may receive a la carte. Permission is required to receive a la carte. No seconds will be given without permission. See prices below.

In an effort to reduce food waste we will implement these requirements before children can receive a la carte items:

- All food must be eaten from the 1st serving.
- An empty tray must be brought back
- Sweets are limited

**Side entree: \$.85**  
**Fruit: \$.85**  
**Milk: \$.50**  
**Vegetable: \$0.75**
