Online "Back-to-School" packet - still waiting for TADS

We are still waiting for TADS to complete our "back-to-school" forms so they can be filled out online instead of paper & pencil. The plan is still for TADS to let the office know when the packets are ready. Then we will send out an email explaining this online process. In the email there will be instructions for families to click a link in the email which will take them to the TADS website. All "back-to-school" forms will be done in this manner. If you have already registered by "traditional" paper form, unfortunately you will have to re-enter the information of the registration. Once you enter essential information, the forms will be pre-populated. This will simplify the process. All forms need to be filled out by Sept. 1.
