"Not everything that can be counted counts and not everything that counts can be counted."



That said, certain assessments can be helpful to us in guiding a school's curriculum and instruction. This week MHRS students will complete NWEA, FAST and Aimsweb assessments that are designed to indicate students' level of mastery in both reading and math as we begin the school year. At mid-year and again in the spring, students complete additional assessments to measure growth in those same areas.

In the end, of course, learning--not testing--is our most important purpose here at school; and, fortunately here at MHRS, students benefit from an education that addresses both academics and the spirit.
