**Aim Higher Scholarships - <https://aimhigherfoundation.org/>**

The Aim Higher Scholarship is a \$1,000, student-based scholarship awarded to K-8 students from families with demonstrated financial need. Once a student is awarded the scholarship, they will continue to receive an additional \$1,000 scholarship each year up to and through 8th grade as long as the yearly financial aid application continues to show need. To be eligible for the Aim Higher Scholarship, a student must enroll in or have plans to apply to the grades K-8 in a K-6, K-8, or K-12 Catholic school in the Archdiocese. Eligible students must demonstrate financial need as determined by the TADS financial aid application. Applications for the 2022-23 school year will be accepted through March 1.
