Beginning on Wednesday February 9th:

MHRS has adopted the 5 day isolation/quarantine COVID protocol for students and staff. These are the items the school will communicate with families when families/students are given a return to school date.

**Positive case:**

- The positive case may return to school on \_\_\_(date: Day 6)\_\_\_ as long as they are fever free for 24 hours without the use of fever-reducing medication, and symptoms have improved.
- Ask parents to notify the school needing to stay home anytime day 6-10.
- Between \_\_\_Day 6 and Day 10\_\_\_ they will need to wear a well fitting face mask at all times, except for when eating or drinking, while they are in school.
- If they are unable or unwilling to wear a face mask their return date will be \_\_\_\_ (date: day 11)\_\_\_.
- If the positive case returns to school on days 6-10 and is not wearing their mask appropriately they will be referred to administration. If your student is unwilling to wear the mask appropriately, they will need to complete the 10 days at home.



**Household exposure:**

- No longer need to quarantine (vaccinated or unvaccinated)
- Stay home if symptoms develop
- No requirement to mask at school
