### Important Reminders

*School breakfasts and lunches* are no longer free, with a couple of exceptions: kindergarten breakfast is free through a state program & students of families who qualify & apply for the reduced/free lunch program. Breakfast for grades 1-8 is served from 7:30 -8:00 a.m. Preschool and Kindergarten go down together as a class. Lunch starts at 11:40 for grades 5 and 6, 11:50 for Little Lambs, 11:55 for Kindergarten, 12:00 for grades 1 and 2, 12:05 for grades 3/4 and 12:30 for grades 7 and 8. Lunch recess starts at 12:30 for K-6.
