Our Friends in Heaven, Pray for Us

Blessed John of Fiesole was a famous painter who was born in Italy near the end of the 14 century. He entered the Dominican convent and was given the name Brother John (Fra Giovanni). His talent of painting was merited and he was contracted to frescoing several rooms in the Vatican Place in 1445- 1449. He led a poor and humble life and refused any honors. The Incarnation was one of his favorite themes and he painted over 25 variations of it. He painted many angels and he became known as Fra Angelio. He died February 18, 1455 in Rome. Pope John Paul II declared him to be the universal patron of all artists.

The Aim Higher Foundation Scholarship



Applications for the 2023 -2024 school year will be accepted during the following periods:

November 1, 2022 through February 22, 2023

May 30, 2023 through August 11, 2023

The Aim Higher Scholarship is a \$1,000 student-based scholarship awarded to K - 8 students from families with demonstrated financial need. Once a student is awarded the scholarship, they will continue to receive an additional \$1,000 scholarship each year, up to and through 8th grade, as long as the yearly financial aid application continues to show need. The scholarship will also follow the student from year to year if he or she transfers to another Catholic school in the Archdiocese of St. Paul and Minneapolis. Eligible students must demonstrate financial need as determined by the TADS financial aid application.
