**Our Friends in Heaven, Pray for Us**  
In 1502, Blessed Sebastian of Aparicio was born in Spain. He helped support his family by being a shepherd until he was 15 years old. He continued to help his family by being a servant and farm hand. Eventually, he moved to Mexico and helped the farmers by building plows and wagons and even created roads to help connect towns for trading. He became wealthy but lived a simple life, giving most of his money to the poor. At the age of 60, he married but it only lasted a year before his wife died. He married again, and his second wife died after a year. He gave up all he had and became a Franciscan where he begged for food for himself, his Franciscan brothers and the poor that they cared for. He had similar attributes of St. Francis of Assisi with animals. He worked hard in caring for others and making their lives better. Many of the roads that he built are still used today. He is the patron saint of travelers and road builders.
