Our Friends in Heaven, Pray for Us

Saint Katherine Drexel was born in Philadelphia in 1858. Her father was a prominent banker and she lost her mother when she was only five weeks old. Her father remarried and they had another child. Katherine and her sister were educated by private tutors while the family traveled the United States and Europe. The family was faithful to their faith and practiced the Spiritual and Corporal Works of Mercy.

As Saint Katherine watched her stepmother suffer and die of cancer, she realized that no amount of money could take away pain and suffering. She received spiritual direction from Fr. James O' Connor and as she grew older, she noticed that the Native Americans needed help. While touring Europe with her sisters, they had a private meeting with Pope Leo XIII. He suggested to her that she become a missionary to help the Native Americans.

After discussing with Fr. James O' Connor, she decided to dedicate her life and her inheritance to help the Native Americans and the African Americans. She established the Sisters of the Blessed Sacrament for Indians and Colored. She opened schools and missions to help these people and by the time of her death, there was 50 missions and 63 schools in the United States. She is the patron saint of racial justice and philanthropists and her feast day is March 3.

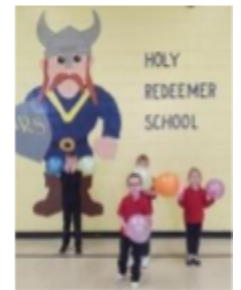
