Helmets are optional for Gr. 5 - 8.



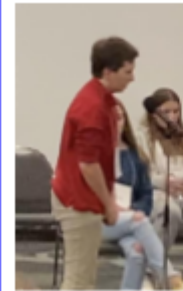

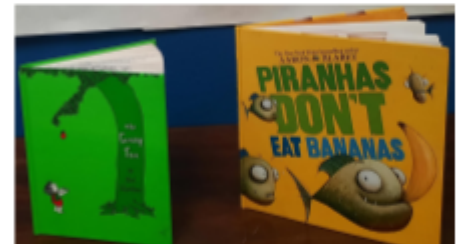
