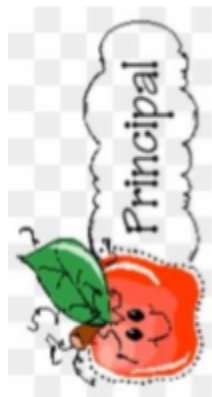

**Families -** We are in Holy Week, the last week of Lent, which is a wonderful time to take a little more time for prayer. Praying the Sorrowful Mysteries of the Rosary or the Stations of the Cross are excellent choices this week. The Triduum begins at sundown on Holy Thursday and reaches the highest point at Easter Vigil and concludes on Easter Sunday. The liturgies during these three days may seem to be separate but they really are one continuous celebration of Jesus' Passion, Death and Resurrection. Triduum is Latin for "three days." Please try to attend the liturgies that you are able this Triduum, especially if you have not attended them before.

We will have our Easter Break starting tomorrow, Thursday, April 6 through Monday, April 10. School will resume on Tuesday, April 11.
