Our Friends in Heaven, Pray for Us:

Saint Thomas Villanueva was born in Spain and was a son of a miller in 1488. He became a theology professor when he was 26. In 1516, he chose to enter the Order of St. Augustine at Salamanca and was ordained in 1520. He was the first to send Augustinian missionaries to the New World where they helped evangelize the area of modern Mexico. In 1544, he accepted the position of archbishop of Valencia. He was committed to the needs of the poor and founded colleges for the children of new converts and the poor. Although he did not attend the Council of Trent, he was a supporter of the Tridentine reforms throughout Spain. He died in 1555 and is the patron saint of Villanova University in Philadelphia and some churches in Mexico dedicated to him have a fiesta in his honor.

Please drop off your treats at the Parish house on Saturday, September 23, from 3 p.m. - 5 p.m. or Sunday, September 24, before 10 a.m.

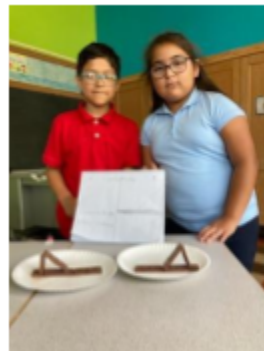
