Saint Frumentius was born in Lebanon. While he was on a voyage in the Red Sea with Saint Aedesius, there was a shipwreck and they were the only two survivors. They were taken to the royal court of Ethiopia at Aksum. He soon attained a high position of secretary and Aedesius was the royal cup bearer. They introduced Christianity to the people. Eventually he went to Egypt to ask St. Athanasius to send a missionary to Ethiopia. Frumentius was consecrated a Bishop and converted many on his return to Aksum. Saint Frumentius and Saint Aedesius are considered the apostles of Ethiopia. St. Frumentius feast day is October 27

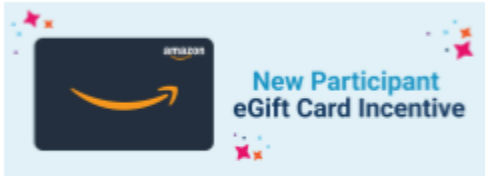
