Saint David was son of King Sant of South Wales and St. Non. After he was ordained a priest, he was involved in missionary work and founded many monasteries. St. David and his monks only drank water while doing heavy labor and intense study each day. It has been reported that he was elected archbishop by the patriarch of Jerusalem while on a visit to the Holy Land. It is also said that he invoked a council that ended the last vestiges of Pelagianism. He died around 589 and his saying "Do the little things" is still well-known in Wales. St. David's feast day is March 1.
